



Theme: Recognition and Appreciation

Overview

Purpose: Celebrate OOSH Educators Day through a fun, interactive scavenger hunt that fosters gratitude and recognition.

Duration: 30-45 minutes

Setting: After school care (indoor and/or outdoor depending on which clues you use).

Links to My time, Our place

Outcome 1.4: Children learn to interact in relation to others with care, empathy and respect.

Outcome 2.1: Children develop a sense of belonging to groups and communities and an understanding of the reciprocal rights and responsibilities necessary for active community participation.

Outcome 2.3: Children become aware of fairness.

Outcome 3.2: Children take increasing responsibility for their own health and physical wellbeing.

Outcome 4.1: Children develop dispositions for learning such as curiosity, cooperation, confidence, creativity, commitment, enthusiasm, persistence, imagination and reflexivity.

Outcome 5.1: Children interact verbally and non-verbally with others for a range of purposes.

Setup

Prepare clue cards and hide them in designated locations.

Provide paper, pencils, art materials, and any required props.

Create a display area titled "Appreciation Station" for kids to post their creations.

Prepare paper tokens (stars, hearts, stickers) to reward completed tasks.

Wrap-Up

End at the Appreciation Station. Kids post their drawings, notes, cards, or tokens.

Host a mini awards ceremony or open mic for kids to express thanks.

Optional Extras

Certificates for kids
Badges for educators
Group photo in front of the Appreciation Station



Printable Clue Cards

Print each clue and task on a separate card or sheet.

Use bold for clues and italics for tasks.

You can cut and distribute them as the children complete each step or hide them at each location.

Facilitator Checklist

Before the Event:
Print and cut out clue cards
☐ Identify and prep each clue location
Gather materials: paper, pencils, sticky notes, building blocks, books, props, tokens
Prepare the Appreciation Station display wall or table
Set up the Mystery Box with pre-written missions inside
During the Hunt:
☐ Brief children on the scavenger hunt rules and theme
Assign team leaders or group facilitators if needed
Ensure each group starts at a different clue to avoid crowding
☐ Take photos of key moments (if permission granted)
☐ Hand out tokens as tasks are completed
After the Hunt:
☐ Host the mini celebration or open mic at the Appreciation Station
